ASSUMPTION

§§567.020, 578.421, and 610.131 - Protection of children from sex trafficking

Oversight notes that the Department of Corrections, Department of Public Safety - Missouri State Highway Patrol, Department of Social Services, Missouri Office of Prosecution Services, Office of State Courts Administrator and State Public Defender's Office each have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

House Amendments (HA) 1, 2 and 4:

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol**, the **Department of Corrections**, the **Office of the State Courts Administrator**, and the **Office of the State Public Defender** each assume the amendments would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Oversight has no information to the contrary, therefore, **Oversight** assumes HA 1, HA 2 and HA 4 have no fiscal impact.
