FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Office of State Courts Administrator, Department of Social Services, Department of Mental Health, Department of Public Safety-Missouri State Highway Patrol and Department of Labor and Industrial Relations assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Springfield Police Department** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

In response to a previous version, officials from the St. Louis County Department of Justice, St. Louis County Police Department, Boone County Sheriff's Department, and Joplin Police Department each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the Office of State Courts Administrator, Department of Mental Health, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Department of Social Services, Department of Public Safety-Missouri State Highway Patrol, St. Louis County Department of Justice Services, St. Louis County Police Department, Springfield Police Department, Boone County Sheriff's Department, and Joplin Police Department have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

House Amendment 1

Officials from the Office of State Courts Administrator, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Department of Public Safety-Missouri State Highway Patrol, Department of Social Services, and Department of Mental Health assume House Amendment 1 to the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight assumes House Amendment 1 will have no fiscal impact on state or local governments.
