§§167.020, and 173.1155 - School registration for dependents of military members

Oversight notes that the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, Department of Higher Education, Department of Public Safety - Missouri National Guard, Missouri State University, University of Central Missouri and Wellsville-Middletown R-1 have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the **State Technical College of Missouri** states his bill could have a slight negative fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes a slight negative impact can be absorbed; therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

In response to a previous version, **Francis Howell School District** stated the proposal would not have a direct first impact on their organization.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other school districts and colleges & universities were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
