FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** assume there may be some impact but there is no way to quantify that currently. Any significant changes will be reflected in future budget requests.

Officials at the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

In response to a previous version, officials at the **Department of Social Services** assumed no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Oversight notes that the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education and the Department of Social Services each has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Officials at the **Wellsville-Middletown R-1 School District** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

In response to a previous version, officials at the **Francis Howell School District**, the **Sherwood Cass R-VIII School District** and the **Centralia R-VI Schools** each assumed no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other schools were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
