FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at **St. Louis County** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

In response to a previous version, officials at the **Monroe County Assessor** and the **Jackson County Sheriff's Office** each assumed no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

Oversight assumes the proposal will not have a direct fiscal impact on political subdivisions. However, Oversight notes that the term "official" is not defined in the committee substitute. The original bill referred to a "document in the possession of *any county employee or official* that the treasurer requests for the purposes of reviewing a warrant"; however, the committee substitute is not as clear ("document in the possession of *any official* that the treasurer requests for the purpose of reviewing a warrant"). Oversight notes the official referred to in the committee substitute does not appear to be limited to being a county official, but could be one not affiliated with the county, such as a state or federal official. However, Oversight will not reflect a direct fiscal impact from this bill.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other counties and sheriffs were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
