ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri Ethics Commission (MEC)** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. However, if the Commission identifies significant violations during the process established in Section 105.955.14 (2), (3), RSMo or complaints received increase significantly an investigator would be required to provide proper oversight.

Oversight assumes that should MEC have a significant increase in complaints, the MEC could require additional resources.
