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FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at **Atchison County** assume a savings of \$3,000 annually in publication costs from this proposal.

Officials at **Henry County** assume a savings of \$1,700 annually in publication costs from this proposal.

Officials at **Johnson County** assume a savings of \$1,600 annually in publication costs from this proposal.

Officials at **McDonald County** assume a savings of \$2,000 annually in publication costs from this proposal.

Officials at the **County of Scotland** assume a savings of \$1,500 annually in publication costs from this proposal.

Officials at the **County of Webster** assume a savings of \$1,700 annually in publication costs from this proposal.

Oversight assumes this proposal requires the county financial statements to be published on a county website or in a newspaper of general circulation each year in the month of March. Oversight assumes the cost of the proposal can be absorbed within the county's budget should the county decide to publish the financials through a newspaper of general circulation. Oversight assumes most of the counties in the State of Missouri have a county website. Using the counties above as an example, if the average of the six counties publication costs is \$1,917 and all 114 counties in Missouri published their financials on their website, the potential savings could be up to \$218,538 (\$1,917 * 114) per year. Oversight is unclear on who currently posts their financials to their website. If the counties decide to post their financials on their website, Oversight assumes there could be a potential savings that could exceed \$100,000 per year from this proposal. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a potential savings in publication costs for counties to post their financials through their county website that could exceed \$100,000 annually from this proposal.

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ASSUMPTION (continued)

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other counties were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. For a general listing of political subdivisions included in our database, please refer to www.legislativeoversight.mo.gov.

Officials at the Office of State Auditor assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill gives all non-charter counties the discretion to publish the annually-required county financial statement on a dedicated county website in lieu of publishing it in a newspaper.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
