ASSUMPTION

§610.100 - Sunshine law

Oversight notes that the **Attorney General's Office, Department of Public Safety - Missouri State Highway Patrol, Office of Secretary of State, Joplin Police Department, Springfield Police Department, St. Louis County Police Department** and **St. Louis County Department of Justice Services** have each stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other police and sheriffs' departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
