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#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State (SOS)**, **Missouri Senate**, and **Missouri House of Representatives** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Kansas City Election Board** assume the proposal will have an immaterial fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Platte County Board of Elections** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that upon inquiring with **Office of the Secretary of State** the SOS stated printing costs are paid for by Local Election Authorities (LEAs), and may vary depending on which ballot vendor they use. So while the state's costs could increase to some degree, the SOS has a cost share in the primary and general elections where ballot measures would appear, the main increase in expenditure would go to the LEAs and the best estimate the SOS could give us was "unknown."

**Oversight** assumes that the proposal will result in larger ballot titles and could result in increased ballot printing and publication costs. Therefore, Oversight will reflect an unknown cost less than \$100,000 to the state and an unknown cost to local election authorities for each general election.

#### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

#### FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill requires ballot titles to be written in plain language and that the ballot contain a specified example of the effect of a "yes" or "no" vote on the ballot measure. Examples are limited to 50 words in the same way as ballot titles and may be litigated in the same manner as a ballot title challenge under Chapter 116, RSMo.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
