ASSUMPTION

§§43.503 and 43.665 - Website to check serial number of a firearm

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri State Highway Patrol (MHP)** estimate this project will take approximately 350 hours to complete in-house and estimates the cost at \$10,000. The MHP states these costs can be absorbed with existing resources.

Oversight does not have any information contrary to that provided by MHP, but will reflect MHP's impact of \$0 to \$10,000 cost to the Highway Fund in FY 2020 for fiscal note purposes.

Oversight notes that the **Department of Natural Resources**, **Department of Conservation**, **Joplin Police Department**, **Springfield Police Department**, **St. Louis County Department of Justice Services** and **St. Louis County Police Department** have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organizations.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

This bill requires the State Highway Patrol to establish a web page with stolen firearm information including the serial number of firearms reported stolen. The information shall be searchable by serial number and is subject to appropriation.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
