AN ACT

To repeal section 537.170, RSMo, relating to waivers by blind employees.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 537.170, RSMo, is repealed, to read as follows:

2 ~~[537.170. It shall hereafter be lawful for any blind person over the age of~~
3 ~~eighteen years to agree to and with his or her employer to waive his or her right~~
4 ~~to damages or compensation for any personal injury arising out of or in the course~~
5 ~~of his or her employment for which injury such blindness was the direct or~~
6 ~~contributory cause and any such agreement shall be valid and binding upon the~~
 ~~parties thereto.]~~
