# HOUSE BILL NO. 191

### AN ACT

To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto three new sections relating to the designation of memorial highways.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto three new sections, to be known as sections 227.462, 227.547, and 227.550, to read as follows:

**227.462. The portion of Interstate 70 from State Highway A continuing east to Lake St. Louis Boulevard in St. Charles County shall be designated as the "Ralph Barrale Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with the costs to be paid by private donations.**

**227.547. The portion of State Highway E from Lafayette Street South to Outer Road 70 East in Lafayette County shall be designated the "Firefighter Jeff Sanders Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with the costs to be paid by private donations.**

**227.550. The portion of State Highway 6 beginning from U.S. State Highway 169 continuing east to Riverside Road through the city of St. Joseph in Buchanan County shall be designated as "Firefighter Travis Owens Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with costs to be paid for by private donations.**
