AN ACT

To amend chapter 164, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to operating levies for school purposes.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 164, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 164.401, to read as follows:

164.401. A school board may vote to remove the school district's operating levy for school purposes from the definition of "levies upon taxable real property in such redevelopment project by taxing districts" as set forth in subsection 1 of section 99.845. Before the school board may vote on the matter, the question shall be placed on the agenda at two consecutive meetings of the school board, and public comments on the matter shall be allowed at both meetings. The school board may then vote upon the matter. If at least a two-thirds majority of the school board votes in favor of removing the operating levy from the definition, the definition shall not include the district's operating levy for school purposes.
