AN ACT

To amend chapter 9, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to historically black college and university week.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 9, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 9.170, to read as follows:

2 **9.170. The third week of September shall be known as "Historically Black College**
3 **and University Week." The citizens of this state are encouraged to observe the week with**
4 **appropriate events and activities recognizing the importance of historically black colleges**
5 **and universities, especially Lincoln University and Harris-Stowe State University, the two**
6 **historically black colleges and universities located in Missouri.**
