AN ACT

To amend chapter 67, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to dogs.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 67, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 67.142, to read as follows:

67.142. 1. Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to limit in any manner the
authority of any village; town; city, including home rule city; or county to prohibit dogs
from running at large or to further control or regulate dogs within its boundaries,
provided that no such ordinance, order, policy, or regulation is specific to breed.

5 2. The general assembly hereby occupies and preempts the entire field of legislation 6 regarding in any way the control or regulation of specific breeds of dogs to the complete 7 exclusion of any order, ordinance, policy, or regulation by any village; town; city, including 8 any home rule city; or county in this state. Any existing or future order, ordinance, policy, 9 or regulation in this field is or shall be null and void.
