AN ACT

To amend chapter 9, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the Battle of St. Louis memorial day.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 9, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 9.117, to read as follows:

2 **9.117. May twenty-sixth of each year shall be known as "Battle of St. Louis**
3 **Memorial Day" in the state of Missouri. Citizens of this state are encouraged to participate**
4 **in appropriate events and activities to commemorate the only battle of the American**
5 **Revolution fought in what would become the state of Missouri.**
