## AN ACT

To amend chapter 21, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to senators who represent Missouri in the United States Senate.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 21, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 21.438, to read as follows:

21.438. 1. Each senator who represents Missouri in the United States Senate shall,
from time to time, appear before the general assembly of this state to provide information
on the activities of the federal government and the interaction of federal law with the laws
and constitution of this state. The senator shall also act on the general assembly's
recommendations regarding measures or acts it deems necessary and expedient to serve
the best interests of Missouri.
The general assembly, acting as a committee as a whole, may enforce the

8 provisions of this section by subpoena under its rules and procedures on any occasion in

9 which a senator who represents Missouri in the United States Senate has failed to appear

10 before the general assembly for an unreasonable period of time.
