AN ACT

To amend chapter 311, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to Missouri bourbon whiskey.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 311, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 311.025, to read as follows:

311.025. To qualify as "Missouri Bourbon" or "Missouri Bourbon Whiskey", and

2 to be labeled as such, a product shall be a spirit that meets the following conditions: all

3 corn used in the mash must be Missouri-grown corn; the product shall be mashed,

4 fermented, distilled, aged, and bottled in Missouri; and the product shall be aged in

5 Missouri in oak barrels manufactured in Missouri.
