	WHEREAS, the City of St. Louis, St. Louis County, and the state of Missouri support
2	professional sports teams in our state; and
3	
4	WHEREAS, Major League Soccer (MLS) is in the process of selecting a city to host one
5	of the two remaining expansion teams as part of its plan to bring the number of teams in the
6	league up to twenty-six; and
7	
8	WHEREAS, soccer has a long history in St. Louis, including successful amateur clubs
9	in the mid Twentieth Century; St. Louis University winning multiple NCAA titles during the
10	1960s; a North American Soccer League team, the St. Louis Stars, from 1968 to 1977; and two
11	Major Indoor Soccer League teams, the St. Louis Steamers from 1979 to 1988 and the St. Louis
12	Storm from 1989 to 1992; and
13	
14	WHEREAS, six of the seventeen players on the famous 1950's United States Men's
15	National Soccer Team, which upset England in a game called "The Miracle Match", were from
16	St. Louis; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, since May 2014, the St. Louis Football Club (FC) has successfully operated
19	in the United Soccer League Championship, which is a Division II Professional League under
20	the United States Soccer Federation and one tier below MLS; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, St. Louis has hosted several international exhibition games, also known as
23	friendlies, in Busch Stadium and the Edward Jones Dome with teams including Chelsea, Inter
24	Milan Manchester City, and Real Madrid; the men's national teams of Argentina, Bosnia and
25	Herzegovina, and Ivory Coast; and the women's national teams of New Zealand and the United
26	States; and

28	WHEREAS, the first qualifying match of the 2018 FIFA World Cup between St. Vincent
29	and the Grenadines and the United States was played in Busch Stadium; and

30	WHEREAS, over ten percent of St. Louis residents participate in soccer, and that rate
31 32	is three percent higher than the national average; and
33	WHEREAS, St. Louis offers a large potential fan base to a MLS team; and
34	
35	WHEREAS, a proposal for a MLS expansion team in St. Louis has been submitted to
36	MLS; and
37	
38	WHEREAS, previous attempts to entice professional sports teams to the St. Louis area
39	placed an unfair burden on taxpayers; and
40	
41	WHEREAS, the current proposal features a stadium that would be overwhelmingly
42	financed privately; and
43	
44	WHEREAS, this effort would deliver an exciting new professional team without
45	siphoning public funds; and
46	WHEREAS St. Louis could convine a MLS from with out the owner of owner to a
47 48	WHEREAS, St. Louis could acquire a MLS team without the use of any new tax
40 49	incentives; and
49 50	WHEREAS, a MLS team would contribute to economic growth in the region; and
50	WHEREAS, a WILS team would contribute to economic growth in the region, and
52	WHEREAS, a MLS team in St. Louis is a smart investment for MLS and for the St.
53	Louis region and state of Missouri:

55	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the House of
56	Representatives of the One Hundredth General Assembly, First Regular Session, the Senate
57	concurring therein, hereby encourage and urge Major League Soccer to give serious
58	consideration to placing one of its expansion teams in St. Louis; and

60	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of
61	Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for MLS
62	commissioner Don Garber, Governor Mike Parsons, and St. Louis Mayor Lyda Krewson.
