AN ACT

Relating to Missouri school counseling week.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

	WHEREAS, school counselors are employed in public and private schools to help

5	abilities, strengths, interests, and talents as these traits relate to career awareness and
6	development; and

8	WHEREAS, school counselors help parents focus on ways to further the educational,
9	personal, and social growth of their children; and

11	WHEREAS, school counselors work with teachers and other educators to help students
12	explore their potential and set realistic goals for themselves; and

14	WHEREAS, school counselors seek to identify and utilize community resources that can
15	enhance and complement comprehensive school counseling programs and help students become
16	productive members of society; and

18	WHEREAS, comprehensive developmental school counseling programs are considered
19	an integral part of the educational process that enables all students to achieve success in school:

21	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the House of
22	Representatives of the One Hundredth General Assembly, First Regular Session, the Senate
23	concurring therein, hereby proclaim the first full week of February of each year as "Missouri
