AN ACT

To amend chapter 173, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to higher education tuition rates.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 173, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 173.272, to read as follows:

173.272. 1. For purposes of this section, the term "program of study" means a program of study offered by a public institution of higher education to which students are admitted.

2. A public institution of higher education may charge differential tuition rates based on program of study.

3. If a public institution of higher education charges differential tuition rates as allowed under subsection 2 of this section, the tuition rate for a program of study shall become effective upon the student's admission to the program of study and shall be based on the costs incurred by the institution to provide the program of study for students.
