AN ACT

Relating to national American history and founders month.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

	WHEREAS, we are approaching our nation's semiquincentennial anniversary; and

3	WHEREAS, America has long been a beacon of hope, individual
4	liberty, freedom, and pursuit of happiness; and

6	WHEREAS, our nation depends on an active citizenry, well educated in civics and
7	history, to maintain our system of government; and

9	WHEREAS, our history consists of our nation's Founding Fathers, the men who wrote
10	the constitution and the Declaration of Independence, and the free governments of the ancient
11	world, Athens and the Roman Republic, which informed their labor; and

13	WHEREAS, we are most desirous to avoid the fate of decline, decay, and dissolution,
14	which laid low the glories of the ancients who first developed free institutions of government;

17	WHEREAS, recent studies suggest that a sizeable number of Americans lack basic
18	literacy regarding the history of America or the structure of our constitution; and

20	WHEREAS, the month of November seamlessly encompasses other important dates to
21	our national character, including Election Day, Veterans Day, and Thanksgiving; and

23	WHEREAS, the month of November is ideally situated to allow schools to continue to
24	develop ideas for the rest of the school calendar; and
