WHEREAS, the City of St. Louis, St. Louis County, and the state of Missouri support professional sports teams in our state; and

WHEREAS, Major League Soccer (MLS) is in the process of selecting a city to host one of the two remaining expansion teams as part of its plan to bring the number of teams in the league up to twenty-six; and

WHEREAS, soccer has a long history in St. Louis, including successful amateur clubs in the mid Twentieth Century; St. Louis University winning multiple NCAA titles during the 1960s; a North American Soccer League team, the St. Louis Stars, from 1968 to 1977; and two Major Indoor Soccer League teams, the St. Louis Steamers from 1979 to 1988 and the St. Louis Storm from 1989 to 1992; and

WHEREAS, six of the seventeen players on the famous 1950's United States Men's National Soccer Team, which upset England in a game called "The Miracle Match", were from St. Louis; and

WHEREAS, since May 2014, the St. Louis Football Club (FC) has successfully operated in the United Soccer League Championship, which is a Division II Professional League under the United States Soccer Federation and one tier below MLS; and

WHEREAS, St. Louis has hosted several international exhibition games, also known as friendlies, in Busch Stadium and the Edward Jones Dome with teams including Chelsea, Inter Milan, Manchester City, and Real Madrid; the men's national teams of Argentina, Bosnia and Herzegovina, and Ivory Coast; and the women's national teams of New Zealand and the United States; and

WHEREAS, the first qualifying match of the 2018 FIFA World Cup between St. Vincent and the Grenadines and the United States was played in Busch Stadium; and

30 **WHEREAS**, St. Louis offers a large potential fan base to a MLS team; and

32 **WHEREAS**, a proposal for a MLS expansion team in St. Louis has been submitted to
33 MLS; and

35 **WHEREAS**, previous attempts to entice professional sports teams to the St. Louis area
36 placed an unfair burden on taxpayers; and

38 **WHEREAS**, the current proposal features a stadium that would be overwhelmingly
39 financed privately; and

41 **WHEREAS**, this effort would deliver an exciting new professional team without
42 siphoning public funds; and

44 **WHEREAS**, St. Louis could acquire a MLS team without the use of any new tax
45 incentives; and

47 **WHEREAS**, a MLS team would contribute to economic growth in the region; and

49 **WHEREAS**, a MLS team in St. Louis is a smart investment for MLS and for the St.
50 Louis region and state of Missouri:

52 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the members of the House of
53 Representatives of the One Hundredth General Assembly, First Regular Session, the Senate
54 concurring therein, hereby encourage and urge Major League Soccer to give serious
55 consideration to placing one of its expansion teams in St. Louis; and

57 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of
58 Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for MLS
59 commissioner Don Garber, Governor Mike Parson, and St. Louis Mayor Lyda Krewson.
