To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to the designation of memorial highways.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto two new sections, to be 2 known as sections 227.456 and 227.468, to read as follows:

227.456. The portion of U.S. State Highway 50 from Business 50 east to the
interchange with PCA Road in Johnson County shall be designated the "Trooper John N
Greim Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain
appropriate signs designating such highway, with the costs to be paid by private donations.
227.468. The portion of State Highway 33 from State Highway A continuing to
South Street in Clinton County shall be designated the "Trooper Fred L Walker Memorial
Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs
