	WHEREAS, the State of Missouri and Republic of China (Taiwan) entered into a sister-
2	state relationship in 1980; and
3	
4	WHEREAS, Missouri and Taiwan share the values of freedom, democracy, rule of law,
5	and respect for human rights; and
6	
7	WHEREAS, Taiwan is Missouri's twenty-second largest trading partner; and
8	
9	WHEREAS, the bonds of true friendship and a mutually beneficial trade partnership
10	between Missouri and Taiwan have resulted in strong economic, social, and cultural exchanges;
11	and

13	WHEREAS, a Taiwan Agricultural Trade Goodwill Mission visited Missouri in
14	September 2017, signed letters of intent to purchase Missouri agricultural commodities, and
15	provided an opportunity for Missouri businesses to build a mutually beneficial trade relationship
16	with Taiwan; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, negotiations for a fair and reciprocal bilateral trade agreement between
19	Taiwan and the United States are an important step to further strengthen bilateral trade, which
20	would increase Missouri exports and promote investment in both countries; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, April 10, 2019, marks the fortieth anniversary of the Taiwan Relations Act,
23	96 Pub. L. 8, which is a United States federal law that built a strong foundation for the United
24	States-Taiwan ties and that assures the continuation of commercial, cultural, and other relations
25	between the two countries; and

27	WHEREAS, Taiwan, as a responsible stakeholder in the international community, seeks
28	to meaningfully participate in the World Health Organization, International Civil Aviation

34	celebrate the thirty-ninth anniversary of sister-state relations with Taiwan; welcome even closer
35	bilateral trade and investment ties; and support Taiwan's appropriate participation in
36	international organizations that benefit the health, safety, and well-being of its people; and

38	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of
39	Representatives be instructed to prepare properly inscribed copies of this resolution for United
40	States Secretary of State Mike Pompeo and Director General Jerry S. Chang of the Taipei
41	Economic and Cultural Office in Denver, Colorado.
