## AN ACT

To amend chapter 313, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to prohibiting publishing of the names of lottery winners, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 313, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 313.303, to read as follows:

313.303. 1. The lottery commission, the state lottery or any employee of the state
lottery, any organization with whom the state has contracted to operate the state lottery,
or any of that organization's employees shall not publish the name, address, or any other
identifying information of any person who wins the state lottery if the state lottery has
received a written notification from the prize winner that he or she does not consent to
have their name, address, or any other identifying information published.
2. For purposes of this section, "publish" means to issue information or material

8 in printed or electronic form for distribution or sale to the public.

9 **3.** Any person or entity who violates the provisions of this section by publishing 10 identifying information protected under this section is guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
