## AN ACT

To amend chapter 640, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to hazardous waste sites.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 640, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 640.042, to read as follows:

640.042. 1. For purposes of this section, the term "hazardous waste site" means:

- 2 (1) Any site on the registry of confirmed abandoned or uncontrolled hazardous
  3 waste disposal sites as described in section 260.440;
  - (2) Any hazardous waste facility, as defined in section 260.360; or
- 5 (3) Any site that once contained hazardous waste, as defined in section 260.360, that 6 is under long-term stewardship in order to prevent residual contamination from posing a 7 risk to the public.

8 2. Every three years, the department of natural resources shall notify by mail every 9 owner of property located in Missouri that is within three miles of a hazardous waste site 10 of the existence of such site. The notice shall contain:

- (1) The name of the hazardous waste site;
- (2) Instructions on how to find information about the hazardous waste site on thedepartment's website; and

(3) If the hazardous waste site has the potential for groundwater contamination,
 a statement advising property owners to have any private wells periodically tested.

- 16 **3. The department of natural resources shall post on its website information on all**
- 17 hazardous waste sites in Missouri and a method for members of the public to sign up to
