AN ACT

To repeal sections 376.1040 and 376.1042, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to solicitation and marketing practices of a multiple employer welfare association.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Sections 376.1040 and 376.1042, RSMo, are repealed and two new sections 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 376.1040 and 376.1042, to read as follows:

376.1040. No multiple employer self-insured health plan shall be offered or advertised
to the public [generally]. No plan shall be sold, solicited, or marketed by persons or entities
defined in section 375.012 or sections 376.1075 to 376.1095. Multiple employer self-insured

4 health plans with a certificate of authority approved by the director under section 376.1002

5 shall be exempt from the restrictions set forth in this section.

376.1042. The sale, solicitation or marketing of any plan in violation of section
376.1040 by an agent, agency or broker shall constitute a violation of section 375.141.
