AN ACT

To repeal section 620.2451, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to rural broadband access funding.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 620.2451, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 620.2451, to read as follows:

620.2451. Grants awarded under sections 620.2450 to 620.2458 shall fund the acquisition and installation of retail broadband internet service at speeds of at least twenty-five megabits per-second download and three megabits per-second upload, but that is scalable to higher speeds. **The department shall maintain all moneys received from any governmental entity for the purposes of providing, maintaining, and expanding rural broadband in the state of Missouri.**
