**AN ACT**

To amend chapter 174, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to higher education.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 174, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto two new sections, to be  
2 known as sections 174.255 and 174.337, to read as follows:

**174.255. 1. Southeast Missouri State University shall have authority to develop a  
2 statewide mission in visual and performing arts, computer science, and cybersecurity.**

**3 2. Southeast Missouri State University shall not be required to submit an  
4 application to the coordinating board for higher education seeking a statewide mission  
5 under section 173.030 in order to implement the statewide mission described in this section.**

**174.337. 1. For purposes of this section, the term "concession agreement" means  
2 any license or lease between a private developer and an institution of higher education for  
3 the construction, development, finance, operation, or maintenance of a capital project.**

**4 2. Any concession agreement entered into under this section shall follow the  
5 competitive bidding process for public private partnerships as defined in section 227.601.**

**6 3. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, nothing shall prohibit a  
7 state institution of higher education governed by the provisions of this chapter from  
8 entering into a long-term concession agreement with a private developer to construct,  
9 operate, maintain, and finance a capital project in exchange for annual payments, subject  
10 to abatement for nonperformance.**
