AN ACT

To repeal section 221.150, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to prisoner restraints.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 221.150, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 221.150, to read as follows:

221.150. 1. The county commission of any county in which a prisoner may be confined, whenever satisfied of the necessity of so doing, may make an allowance for placing such prisoner under irons, which shall be paid out of the treasury of the county in which the cause originated.

2. If an inmate is placed in restraints, as that term is defined under section 217.151, county and city jails shall comply with the regulations under section 217.151.
