### AN ACT

To repeal section 544.190, RSMo, relating to rights of law enforcement officers in making arrests.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 544.190, RSMo, is repealed, to read as follows:

2      ~~[544.190. If, after notice of the intention to arrest the defendant, he either  
flee or forcibly resist, the officer may use all necessary means to effect the arrest.]~~
