	WHEREAS, on December 3, 2018, the Organ Procurement and Transplantation Network
2	(OPTN), a division of the United States Department of Health and Human Services, made
3	changes to the national liver distribution policy; and

5	WHEREAS, this policy change does not appear to give weight to locations that have
6	been successful in reducing their waitlists through aggressive organ procurements or through
7	adapting innovative transplant techniques; and
8	
9	WHEREAS, such policy change could lead to prolonged waiting periods and the deaths
10	of many Missourians seeking liver transplants; and
11	
12	WHEREAS, many important health care organizations in Missouri have concerns about
13	such policy change; and

15	WHEREAS, on January 24, 2019, Senator Blunt, Chairman of the Subcommittee on the
16	Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, Education, and Related Agencies, along with
17	Senate Majority Leader McConnell, Senate Committee on Finance Chairman Grassley, Senate
18	Committee on Appropriations Chairman Shelby, Senator Hawley, and other Senators sent a letter
19	to Alex Azar, Secretary of the United States Department of Health and Human Services, to voice
20	concern about how the change in policy would adversely impact the many Americans seeking
21	liver transplants; and
