HB 35 -- SECURITY BREACH OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

SPONSOR: Stacy

This bill requires any person that owns or licenses personal information of Missouri residents to provide notice of a breach of security to the affected consumer within 30 days of the discovery of the breach. If a law enforcement agency determines that notification of the breach may impede a criminal investigation, the notice can be delayed, but must be given with 30 days after the law enforcement agency determines that notice will no longer impede the investigation. Current law requires the notice of a security breach to be made without unreasonable delay.
