HB 99 -- DISADVANTAGE AND MINORITY BUSINESS CONCERNS

SPONSOR: Green

This bill provides that every five years the Office of Administration shall commission a study of the availability of socially and economically disadvantaged small business concerns and minority business enterprises in the marketplace. The bill provides that the Commissioner of Administration shall appoint a committee to oversee the study, and that the House and Senate shall consider legislation to address the disadvantages described in the study.

This bill is the same as HB 2533 (2018).
