HB 265 -- PRODUCTS SOLD IN STATE CAPITOL

SPONSOR: Taylor

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Special Committee on Small Business by a vote of 5 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Legislative Oversight by a vote of 8 to 0.

This bill requires that any non-food product sold in the Missouri State Capitol Building be made in the United States.

This bill is the same as HB 1874 (2018).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that it makes sense for the people's capitol building to sell products made by Missourians, when possible, but to at least be made in the United States.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Taylor.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
