HB 285 -- BILL OF RIGHTS FOR THE HOMELESS

SPONSOR: Franks Jr.

This bill creates a Bill of Rights for homeless persons. No person's rights, privileges, or access to public services may be denied because such person is homeless. The bill defines the term "housing status" and prohibits certain forms of discrimination based upon a person's housing status. A court may award damages and other relief in a civil action alleging a violation of this act.

This bill is the same as HB 1938 (2018).
