HB 292 -- EXPUNGEMENT OF CERTAIN MARIJUANA OFFENSES

SPONSOR: Washington

This bill specifies that if a person has been convicted of the offense of possession of 35 grams or less of marijuana after December 31, 1997 and before August 28, 2019, the court has an affirmative duty to expunge such conviction from all official records. Beginning August 28, 2019, any person convicted of the offense of possession of 35 grams or less of marijuana will have all official records of such conviction expunged by the court the day the person is convicted.
