HCS HB 448 & 206 -- CLORIA BROWN MEMORIAL HIGHWAY

SPONSOR: Pike

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass with HCS" by the Standing Committee on Transportation by a vote of 14 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Administrative Oversight by a vote of 6 to 0.

This bill names a section of road in St. Louis County as the Cloria Brown Memorial Highway. Signage costs are paid by private donation.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the bills will honor former Representative Cloria Brown who was a dedicated public servant and worked tirelessly on behalf of her constituents in the 94th District. The road is located directly in front of her burial site.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Pike and Representative Murphy.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.

INFORMATION PURPOSES ONLY: The location specified in the bill has been approved by the Department of Transportation. There are multiple highway naming processes that can be employed under Chapter 227, RSMo.
