

HB 454 -- A+ Program

SPONSOR: Shull (16)

This bill expands the A+ program to students earning specified college credit in high school. Eligible high school students may receive A+ reimbursement for the cost of tuition, books, and fees for any dual-credit or dual-enrollment course offered in association with a public community college or vocational or technical school.

The bill also changes the eligibility requirement for the A+ program by reducing the requirement that a student attend high school in Missouri from three years to two years.

This bill is similar to HB 2412 (2018).
