

HB 721 -- WAREHOUSING OF CERTAIN ALCOHOL PRODUCTS

SPONSOR: Tate

This bill specifies that any person, firm, or corporation who owns and operates more than one premises licensed to sell intoxicating liquor at retail may, with the permission of the supervisor of liquor control, designate one or more places in this state as a central warehouse in which liquor, except beer and other malt liquor, purchased from a wholesaler may be delivered and stored. The liquor stored in such warehouses may then be transferred to any premises in the state licensed to sell intoxicating liquor at retail which is owned and operated by the same person, firm, or corporation.

This bill is the same as HB 2409 (2018).
