

HCS HBs 743 & 673 -- CRONKITE NEW VOICES ACT (Fishel)

COMMITTEE OF ORIGIN: Standing Committee on General Laws

This bill establishes the "Cronkite New Voices Act," which provides that in both public high schools and public institutions of higher education a student journalist has the right to exercise freedom of speech and of the press in school-sponsored media.

The bill permits school districts and student-media advisors to regulate the number, length, frequency, and format of school-sponsored media. School districts must adopt a written freedom of the press policy that includes reasonable provisions for the time, place, and manner of student expression. The policy may also restrict speech that is offensive or threatening.

The bill forbids school districts from prior restraint of school-sponsored media except in circumstances specified in the bill.

This bill is same as HB 673 (2019) and HB 1940 (2018).
