HB 765 -- EXECUTIVE AGENCY RECORDS

SPONSOR: Shaul (113)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on General Laws by a vote of 11 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Legislative Oversight by a vote of 10 to 0.

This bill modifies the definition of executive agency to include joint legislative committees created by statute or the Constitution of Missouri so that specified record sharing requirements will apply equally to executive branch agencies and such committees.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the bill will help joint committees of the legislature provide more accurate fiscal notes.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Shaul.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
