HB 784 -- SCHOOL FUNDING

SPONSOR: Pogue

Currently, if 10% or more of a school district's assessed valuation is owned by one person who is delinquent in property tax payments, the district may use its assessed valuation for the previous year or its current-year assessed valuation less the assessed valuation of the property for which the taxes are delinquent.

This bill expands this option to include contested property tax payments, and reduces the threshold of the district's assessed valuation that must be owned by the property owner with delinquent or contested property taxes from 10% to 1%.

This bill is the same as HB 2556 (2018).
