

HB 892 -- SEAT BELT LAW

SPONSOR: Rowland

Currently, no person may be stopped, inspected, or detained solely for enforcement of the seat belt law. It may only be enforced as a secondary offense. This bill changes it to be a primary offense, such that a law enforcement officer may stop, inspect, or detain someone solely to enforce the seat belt law.

This bill is the same as HB 2685 (2018).
