

HB 897 -- FINANCIAL INTEREST STATEMENTS

SPONSOR: Rowland

This bill allows the Executive Director of the Missouri Ethics Commission to make financial interest statement records available to the general public in a searchable format by posting them to the Internet together with a search engine feature. The records will remain public documents available by request and subject to applicable fees. A current limit of \$10,000 or more in value for reporting specified stocks, bonds, and other instruments is repealed so that all such investments will now be subject to reporting.

This bill is similar to HB 1889 (2018).
