

HB 947 -- TRAUMA-INFORMED CARE TASK FORCE

SPONSOR: Walker

This bill re-establishes the "Trauma-Informed Care for Children and Families Task Force" which was established by SB 819 in 2018 and terminated in January 2019, by statute. The task force will work to promote the healthy development of children and families by promoting comprehensive trauma-informed support systems and interagency cooperation.

The board shall consist of specified members, that include two members appointed by the Speaker and one member appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives, two members appointed by the President Pro Tem and one member appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate.
