

HB 1024 -- EDUCATION WORK GROUP

SPONSOR: Dogan

This bill requires the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education to create a work group to develop and recommend rigorous academic performance standards relating to workforce development for students in grades one through 12.

The work group shall consist of nine members as appointed by the Governor and all meetings for the work group will be open to the public to provide testimony.

The bill requires the work group to develop alternate academic achievement standards for students with the most significant cognitive disabilities and employability skills curriculum with details for each outlined in the bill.

These standards and curriculum will be presented to the State Board of Education and the General Assembly, which may adopt or request modifications. The work group will dissolve one year after any requested modifications are made.
