

HB 1093 -- DUAL CREDIT SCHOLARSHIPS

SPONSOR: Dohrman

This bill allows students enrolled in a STEM studies enhancement program (an undergraduate program offered by a Missouri higher education institution to high school students that emphasizes applied, advanced skills in any field related to STEM), who have a household income not exceeding 110% of the state median and otherwise meet the provisions of the bill, to receive a dual credit scholarship. The scholarship is based on the average tuition cost of a community college course in the state.
