HB 1144 -- ANIMAL CHIROPRACTORS

SPONSOR: Shull (16)

This bill allows animal chiropractic practitioners, as defined in the bill, to engage in the practice of animal chiropractic and removes animal chiropractic from the definition of "veterinary medicine." The bill specifies that an animal chiropractic practitioner must be either a licensed veterinarian or a licensed chiropractic examiner, both of which must be certified by a veterinary chiropractic association.

This bill is similar to HCS HB 1911 (2018) and SB 746 (2018).
